ATTENDANCE

Students enrolled in St. Vincent de Paul Catholic School are expected to follow the Mississippi State requirements for the number of unexcused absences allowed within a given school year. It is further required students arrive on time.

- 1. Absences and Tardiness patterns will be tracked through a record-keeping system.
- 2. The office will send a letter to the parents of students having accumulated 8 <u>unexcused</u> absences within the school year informing them of the excessive unexcused absences.
- 3. The office will contact the parents after <u>three</u> tardies within a nine week period and issue a one hour detention once a student reaches five unexcused tardies in a nine week period.

Students arriving late:

- o miss part of the academics of the class
- o require special attention and take time that could be used otherwise
- o develop behavior patterns that are undesirable in school and later in work
- o may receive social pressure by peers that can lower their self-esteem

Research has shown:

- o attendance problems correlate directly to achievement problems
- o attendance problems are associated with lack of preparation to enter the work force
- 4. Parents will be informed all tardies and absences will be documented in student records.
- 5. Programs or possible plans for resolution will be set up and parental commitment will need to be obtained.
- 6. Parents/students will be informed of possible afterschool detention requirement if tardies continue.
- 7. Excessive absences may be a factor in consideration for retention.
