This year SVS will be taking 6 teams to the International Economic Summit in Jackson. Twenty-eight 6th graders are participating this year—the most we've ever had! In Jackson they will compete against other middle school teams from across the state for cash prizes.

SVS teams are representing Argentina, El Salvador, Egypt, Ghana, Japan, and Switzerland. At the Summit, each team will act as economic advisors to their chosen country. They will compete for points in several activities including a geography quiz, an economics test, an import/export trading session, an alliance session, and a debate on global economic issues.

Please keep these students in your prayers as they work hard to learn as much as possible and represent our school well. The International Economic Summit will be held on December 5th at Mississippi College.
