## Reminder on how to send in payments

There are many activities at the school, and payments are being sent with no name or indication of what it is for. This is becoming a problem, so please remember the following guidelines:

Cash payments will not be issued receipts unless they are paid in person. Please send any payments in an envelope marked with the student's first and last name, the teacher's name and what the payment is for. If you send in a lunch payment, also include the student's lunch number. If the payment is for more than one child, you will need to note how much you want in each account; otherwise, the office will just divide it evenly.

If you send in a check, you can indicate what it is for in the "For" line on the check. If you have more than one student, you can write one check for lunch, but please indicate all information on the check.
