SVS will continue to teach Safe Environment during the month of October. If you do not want your child to participate, please send in a letter stating that you will teach your own child.



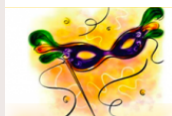
SVS basketball registration is open

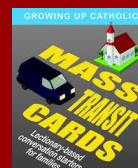
