

A neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) is a hospital nursery that provides 24/7 care for newborn babies who are sick or premature. Most babies are admitted to the NICU within 24 hours of birth, and the length of their stay depends on their health. Some babies may only need to stay a few hours or days, while others may stay for weeks or months. When babies no longer need the specialized care and equipment of the NICU, they are then sent home. This being said we are asking for your help to make their stay a little more comforting.

Blankets will be sent home through your oldest child or available in the office for pickup.




