The Church traditionally held a vigil on All Hallows' Eve when worshippers would prepare themselves with prayers and fasting prior to the feast day itself.

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. All Saints' Day is a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation, requiring Catholics to attend the mass.

All Souls' day

In Roman Catholicism, All Souls' Day is observed on November 2 to remember all the faithful departed who are believed to be in purgatory because they died with the guilt of lesser sins on their souls. The Roman Catholic doctrine says that the prayers of the faithful on earth will help cleanse these souls in order to be pure and fit the Beatific vision.



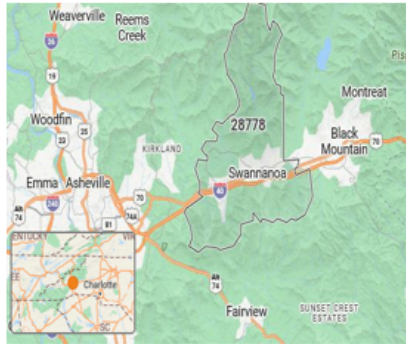

in Swannanoa, North Carolina



As most you know, Swannanoa, North Carolina has been ravaged by Hurricane Helene. The devastation is beyond our comprehension. Many residents are still stranded with no access to food, water and other necessities.

Deacon Bill's son and his family live in Swannanoa, North Carolina. They are safe and their property had minimal damage from the storm, but he is surrounded by complete devastation.

Your prayers and financial assistance are most vital at this time. The Vrazel's are parishioners at St. Margaret Mary's Church in Swannanoa. St. Margaret Mary's has no water or electricity, but they are distributing supplies to the community. Father Mike has reached out to St. Margaret Mary's to offer our financial assistance. At this time, they are not accepting supplies as they do not have any storage space. Therefore, we are asking our Parishioners for monetary donations. *Donations will go directly into the hands of those hit so hard.*

This is the "first phase" of Holy Family's assistance to these communities hit so hard. We may be asking for volunteers in the future to assist as our North Carolina neighbors begin the difficult and challenging task of putting their lives back together.
