

HURRICANE HELENE RELIEF Holy Family Parish to Sponsor St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church in Swannonoa, North Carolina

As most you know, Swannonoa, North Carolina has been ravaged by Hurricane Helene. The devastation is beyond our comprehension. Many residents are still stranded with no access to food, water and other necessities.

Deacon Bill's son and his family live in Swannonoa, North Carolina. They are safe and their property had minimal damage from the storm, but he is surrounded by complete devastation.

Your prayers and financial assistance are most vital at this time. The Vrazel's are parishioners at St. Margaret Mary's Church in Swannonoa. St. Margaret Mary's has no water or electricity, but they are distributing supplies to the community. Father Mike has reached out to St. Margaret Mary's to offer our financial assistance. At this time, they are not accepting supplies as they do not have any storage space. Therefore, we are asking our Parishioners for monetary donations. *Donations will go directly into the hands of those hit so hard*.

Monetary donations can be made in the form of: -Cash -Checks (make your check payable to *Holy Family Parish* and write *"NC Hurricane Relief"* in the memo line) -VISA/MasterCard debit cards, -Gift cards from Lowe's, Home Depot and Walmart.

Please return your donation to the Parish Office or you can drop it in the offertory baskets at masses. Please be sure to note on your donation this is for "*NC Hurricane Relief*".

Our support of the Swannonoa community will be ongoing, but the financial assistance is of the most urgent need at this time. This is the "first phase" of Holy Family's assistance to these communities hit so hard. We may be asking for volunteers in the future to assist as our North Carolina neighbors begin the difficult and challenging task of putting their lives back together.


